Cuddle Quilts - Making and donating quilts for children with long-term disabilities in local hospitals and rehabilitation centers.

Friendship Quilts - Making and donating quilts for residents in hospice and local nursing homes. Quilt sizes are on the website.

Mini-Groups - Member groups that meet in members' homes with or without a theme to share quilting time.
